

Fourways RoadRunners - Code of Conduct

The continued use by Fourways RoadRunners (FRR) of the facilities in Fourways Gardens is set out in our Record of Understanding entered into between FRR, the Fourways Gardens Homeowners Association (FGHA) and the Fourways Gardens Social and Recreation Club and is largely dependent on each Fourways RoadRunners member adhering to this Code of Conduct. Any member found to be in contravention of this Code of Conduct will face disciplinary action by the FRR Club. Repeated offences will lead to the termination of his or her membership. The FRR Club will not allow the misbehaviour of a single member to jeopardize the tenure of the entire FRR Club in Fourways Gardens.

Code of Conduct

Each FRR member is required to adhere to the following code:

1. **Security.** All members of the running club are required to be in possession of an access card issued by FGHA and will be expected to comply with all security arrangements of Fourways Gardens. The Security and Access Control Procedures of Fourways Gardens are of paramount importance and any infringements of these may lead to the cancellation of the Record of Understanding.
2. **Parking of vehicles.** All members (resident and non-resident) shall not park their vehicles in or within the vicinity of the clubhouse parking area or on Camdeboo Road. Vehicles must at all times be parked on the eastern verge of Coral Tree Crescent as close as possible to the starting point for runs.
3. **Start line.** The commencement point for all runs shall be in Coral Tree Crescent at a point directly opposite the clubhouse building. This shall include the finishing of runs and runners will be expected to walk from that point to the clubhouse should they wish to use the club facilities.
4. **Running Times.** Running may take place at any time during the week but Club runs will be held on Tuesday and Thursday evenings commencing at 18h15, and on Saturday mornings at times advertised from time to time.
5. **People in Attendance.** People in attendance at the runs, e.g. time-keepers on Thursdays, and who congregate at the start/finishing point in Coral Tree Crescent, shall not act in a manner to the annoyance of residents. The area shall be kept clean and under no circumstances shall litter of any description be left at that point or in the vicinity.
6. **Runners dress.** Runners shall be respectably dressed and during hours of darkness shall wear reflective clothing or apparel in line with that normally used under these conditions (e.g. reflective belts or bibs).
7. **Running Etiquette.** When running, runners shall where possible, keep to the right hand side of the road and shall not run more than two abreast or to the detriment of any other road user. Runners must conduct themselves in a disciplined manner at all times and under no circumstances must they resort to foul or abusive language or behaviour which may cause offence to residents or other road users.
8. **Complaints.** If runners have any complaint that they wish to have addressed, they must bring the issue to the attention of the running Club committee member who is responsible for liaison with FGHA, who can then take the matter up with the Fourways Gardens Chairman and Social and Recreational Club if deemed necessary.
9. **Clubhouse behaviour.** All running club members are welcome to make use of the Clubhouse facilities provided they shower after their run and are appropriately dressed before entering the clubhouse.
 - a. On Thursday evenings –
FRR are required to shower and return their kit bag to their vehicle before entering the Clubhouse. Members may be casually dressed but are not permitted to enter the Clubhouse wearing running kit. Kit bags may not be left or carried through the Clubhouse or the veranda patio area. FRR must respect the rights of other users of the Club at all times. Only members who are dining as part of Club night, may make use of the tables. Members may make use of tables if these are not being used by diners. Tables may not be reserved.
 - b. On Tuesday evenings –
FRR are required to shower before entering the Pub. Members may be casually dressed but are not permitted to sit in the Pub wearing running kit. Kit bags may be carried through the Clubhouse and left neatly in the Pub area while members enjoy a drink together.
10. **Private Functions.** The Clubhouse, the Pub and Toddlers Town are hired out to Residents and third parties for a variety of functions from time to time. No resident or running club member may enter any one of these facilities if they are in use for a private function.
11. **Alcohol.** Alcohol may only be consumed in the clubhouse, the pub or the patio. The running club is granted special dispensation to take drinks on the lawn after a run on a Tuesday or Thursday evening. All alcohol must be purchased from the Pub.
12. **Member's acknowledgement.** Members of the running club are required to sign this code of conduct before being accepted as a member, as an acknowledgement of their responsibilities. Any transgression thereof will be subject to disciplinary action by the running club committee, which may under certain circumstances include termination of membership and the withdrawal of access facilities for that member.
